Presentation and portfolio review by Mr. Michael Nyeholt and Mr. Terry Ragsdale, Investment Specialist and Research Portfolio Coordinator, of Capital Guardian.

The Consultant was asked to work with all Board members and staff, to communicate well with everyone, and to bring new, fresh ideas to the Board, to provide more education. The Committee requested that KC Chen interact with Mr. Schlachter to challenge and refresh the academic process.
